The Family Promise Mentoring Program is designed to help families overcome these stresses as they work toward becoming a self-sustainable family once again. In the Family Promise Mentoring Program, economically vulnerable families are matched with trained volunteer mentors who work with them, one-on-one, over an extended period of time for approximately one hour each week.

Mentors help individual families define and meet goals to:

- Develop life skills
- Connect with community resources
- Improve their housing and employment situations
- Nurture and support their children

Mentors build committed, trusting relationships. They listen. They offer understanding and respect. They help families overcome challenges and disappointments and celebrate successes.

Since becoming a part of the Kroger Program one year ago FPGHC has received \$587 through this program. **If you have not already enrolled in this program would you consider doing so?**

If you have been enrolled, it's time to re-enroll in the program. Organizations and schools do not need to enroll each year, but each Kroger shopper is required to re-enroll their Kroger Plus Card on an annual basis. Re-enrollment begins this month and dollars will start accumulating beginning Sept. 1, 2015.


