We have three partnerships that allow qualifying families to utilize transitional housing after graduating from the program. Since opening our doors in 2013 we have successfully placed nine families in transitioning housing. In this issue we would like to spotlight First United Methodist Church. During the month of July we were able to place our sixth family with the Helping Hands Ministry. This ministry has been a great support to our families, allowing them the family stabilization, fellowship, and support as well as the opportunity to save money for permanent housing.
