(HUMI), a Washington State based non-profit organization working with communities to fund and create programs helping families facing housing crises.

The model is based on the shared beliefs of the two organizations that a combination of case management, opportunity, and community can empower the families we serve toward self-sufficiency. The mission of the partnership is simple: to ensure children are HOMELESS NO MORE. Family Promise of Greater Houston County is one of ten Family Promise Affiliates selected for the fourth cycle of grants through HUMI.

Families with children under the age of 18 that need rental assistance are encouraged to contact our office at 478-328-8181 for a screening to begin the application process.

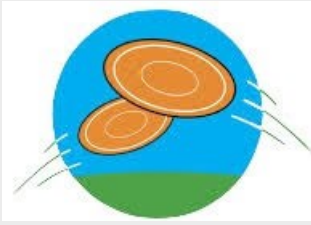
Applicants must:

Other required documents will be discussed during screening.

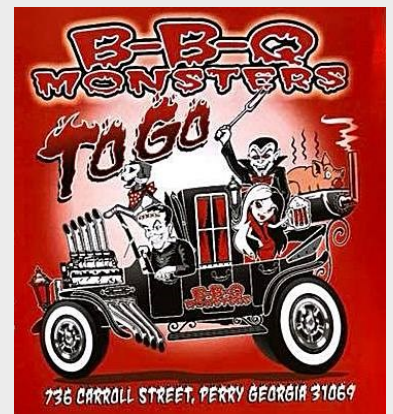

Durante esta pandemia, nuestras comunidades han sido llevadas al extremo. Es más y más difícil para que las familias mantengan la estabilidad económica con cierres de empresas y despedidos. Ahora más que nunca es esencial que las agencias de servicios sociales se acerquen y ofrezcan asistencia a cualquier persona que necesite ayuda económica temporal. Family Promise es una de esas organizaciones locales en el Condado de Houston que está dispuesta a ayudar.

El Programa de Ayuda para la Sostenibilidad de Family Promise está diseñado para ayudar a familias trabajadoras o temporalmente desplazadas con niños que son económicamente frágiles debido a la pandemia. El propósito de este programa es prevenir la falta de vivienda. Hay ciertos requisitos para ser elegible.

- * Debe tener una Identificación válida de Georgia o una Licencia de Conducir.
- * Debe tener hijos menores de 18 años viviendo con usted que están mencionados en el contrato de arrendamiento o alquiler.
- * Debe mostrar prueba de ingresos y la capacidad de continuar pagando después de la asistencia.
- * Debe ser un residente del Condado de Houston.

Si su familia está en crisis y está atrasada con el alquiler o los servicios públicos de electricidad y gas, Family Promise les puede ayudar. Por favor llame a nuestra oficina, 478-328-8181, para programar una evaluación o para obtener más información. La administradora de casos habla español y está disponible martes y jueves de 5:30pm a 7:30pm.
