Director's Corner

Since opening our doors in May 2013 we have received many inquiries and referrals for our program. We are pleased to know our community is becoming aware of our services for homeless families in Houston County. With this in mind we felt it beneficial to share the following information with you; providing some brief details for those interested in referring families to Family Promise.

Quick Facts on Family Promise Services and Program Entry:

The intake process is quite extensive and there is not an immediate entry to the program.

We conduct a phone screening, set up a face to face intake, get a criminal background history, and do a drug screening before a family is approved. The process can take anywhere from 2-4 days business days.

Prospective guests must have children under the age of 18. (Pregnant women with no children will not qualify.)

Prospective guests must contact us directly.

Prospective guests must have documentation for the entire family; birth certificates, social security cards, and personal identification. (Other documentation may be requested as needed.)

Families can stay in the program up to 90 days based on progress and review.

Transportation is available to assist our families with getting to work and other necessary appointments.

If your agency, church, or organization is interested in getting additional information on program services, Family Promise staff is available for presentations Monday - Saturday. Call 328-8181 to schedule an appointment.

Although inappropriate for a guest due to its age and unique maintenance issues (manufactured in the UK), we wanted to give her idea some due consideration. We discussed it with our experts-Jack, Shirley, and Paul. Then we decided we could try to sell the vehicle at auction. Thelma received a tax deductible donation to Family Promise and Jack agreed to do a little work on the car and then take it to auction within the next month. The car was on Jack's lot for two days when it was seen by a local collector and purchased 'as is' for \$1,800. In Jack's words, "That's what happens when God gets involved." 1. Continue Creating Quality Care—our congregations provide loving, caring support through volunteerism, providing meals, shelter and support. Our volunteers are trained to offer just the right level of assistance and their support is crucial to the effectiveness of the program.



2. Creating Capabilities Within Our Guests—while in the program our guests receive education, guidance and counseling on budgeting, job skills, parenting skills, resume writing, filling out job applications and interview skills--all with the goal of helping them get back on their feet. 3. Transitioning to Self-Sustainment—our goal is to help families re-establish themselves in a self-sustainable living situation. Our extensive network of support throughout Houston County enables our guests to use a wide variety of resources to re-establish themselves as thriving members in the community.



4. Fully Funded for the Future—we aim to continually improve our capability to support homeless families by providing streams of income for the Family Promise Program; enabling the program to continue for the foreseeable future.
