New Day Center Update

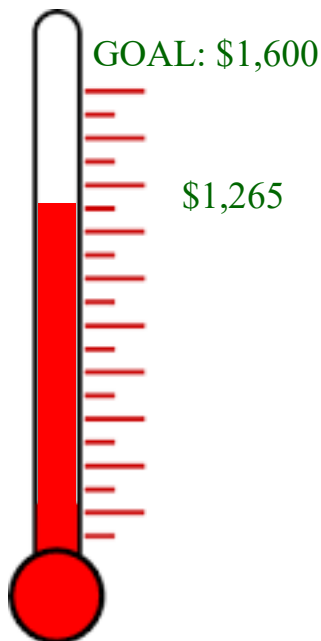
